## **Covid-19 Reopening Resources**



The pause of the pandemic has posed an opportunity for us all to consider the kinds of events we produce, the community work we support, and the audiences we place at the center of our efforts. And the return to live performance is going to look very different in different places, for different events, and for different people and audiences. If you're planning live events for this summer and fall, here are some of the best resources we've found to help guide you in your specific planning.

Live Reopening Guide

This guide was created for Colorado-based performers and experiential creators by Immersive Denver in collaboration with Majestic Collaborations.



Are you planning in-person experiences for the spring, summer, or fall, or considering it? We've compiled a <u>Live Reopening Resource Guide for</u> <u>Immersive Creators</u> of resources and considerations that we think are helpful, including both quick links to some of the local health and regulation information as well as industry best practice documents as they're being developed. We'll continue to keep this updated. Make sure you also stay tuned into local and regional public health advice to help in your planning (we've included a few links in the guide, but you can follow officials on social, tv, or radio as well).

The events in Boulder yesterday were a terrible reminder of the fact that safety takes on many different dimensions anytime we are considering gathering people at events. If you don't already incorporate safety planning into your production design, doing a covid-19 risk assessment and safety plan is a valuable place to start, both to help mitigate transmission risks for your audiences over the next few months as well as to start building a culture of preparedness into your organization.
